This month, we will offer two action stations that include house made apple and cheese waffle pastries with cinnamon ice cream, and gluten free fresh zucchini alfredo, sautéed mushrooms in balsamic vinaigrette, and scratch made chili. The chili will be for sale in cups or pints.
