Farmer’s Market

Our July farmer’s market will be held on Wednesday, July 10 from 11 AM-2 PM in the lobby. In addition to assorted local produce, the following homemade items will also be available for purchase: zucchini and strawberry rhubarb breads, power slaw and zucchini slaw, salsa, fire roasted chili, corn muffins and assorted cheeses. We will offer a sandwich board and our demo station will be zucchini alfredo over lentil pasta.

Residents may use cash or charge items to their monthly statement. Guests and employees must use cash for purchases.
