What Does Yellow Phase Really Mean?

COVID-19 is still a significant threat to the Sherwood Oaks community due to age and health status of our residents. As the region enters the Yellow Phase of the PA Reopening Plan, we must remain diligent with procedures in place. Sherwood Oaks is not in the Yellow Phase. I thank residents and staff both for their important role in maintaining a safe and secure environment here on campus:

- Visitor restrictions
- Screening of all persons at gatehouse before campus entry
- Leave the campus only for medical reasons or obtaining essential supplies
- Wear a mask/face covering when outside your home
- Physical distancing – 6 feet or more from your fellow resident or staff member
- Hand hygiene – wash hands often, especially each time you cough, sneeze, use the bathroom, before eating and after touching surfaces
- Monitor for any respiratory infection symptoms such as cough, fever or sore throat
- If you feel unwell, stay home

I've been in contact with some resident volunteers and staff asking them for input regarding possibly offering outdoor games and opening some areas in the Community Center like the computer room, craft room, wood shop, etc. by appointment, limited persons and hours. - A pop-up message saying that your computer has a virus and is locked. You are directed not to close your computer and to call a 1-888 number. Do not call that number. Call Microsoft at 1-800-642-7676.
- Child Porn emails – if you receive emails stating that your computer's IP address was linked to child porn, delete the email immediately. Do not call the number instructed in the email.
- Apple support email with PDF attachment - says it's a receipt from something you ordered from the App store. Do not open the attachment.
