Vaccinations

I would like to extend a huge thank you to RX Partners and their dedicated team of pharmacists who visited Sherwood Oaks to immunize residents and staff with the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine this week.

CDC vaccination record/card will be given to Independent Living residents after the second dose is administered. The date for the second vaccine is being targeted for early March, but an exact date has not been confirmed yet.

We are all asking when life will go back to normal. Vaccinations are an important first step to combat COVID-19. It is very important to continue social distancing, masking and frequent and consistent hand hygiene.
