Sherwood Oaks independent living residents will be offered Moderna or Pfizer booster shots on Thursday, November 11 in the Main Dining Room. Booster will be based on initial vaccination type. RX Partners has agreed to an earlier start time for the clinic so residents may attend the Veteran's Day celebration, which will be moved to 2 p.m. Plan to bring your vaccination card. The Main Dining Room will not be serving lunch this day; lunch will be available for pick up at the Café counter. We ask that you follow the schedule below based upon your address:
