Housekeeping Credits

New fee schedule goes into effect July 1, and we should clarify when Sherwood Oaks will issue housekeeping credits.

- Resident away from Sherwood Oaks for seven days or more and completes away slip
 - Example resident away for period greater than 7 days and misses two scheduled cleanings – two \$15 weekly cleaning credits will be issued
- Sherwood Oaks cancels scheduled housecleaning due to holiday or staff unavailability.
 - o Example regular scheduled cleaning is Monday, July 4 one \$15 weekly cleaning credit will be issued
- Resident cancels scheduled housecleaning no credit issued

Our housekeeping department vacancy rate continues to be high at over 50%. To assist Nancy O'Leary and her team, some residents volunteered to temporarily forgo regular weekly cleaning. In return, those residents receive a weekly credit for agreed upon dates Sherwood removed them from the cleaning schedule.
