It will require all incoming callers to press a number to be connected to the patio homes 101-360, the community center and the health center. Armstrong offers this service for the 600 patio homes and the 700 apartments. We hope this will help to cut down on the number of robo and scam calls we have been receiving campus wide. The main phone number for Sherwood Oaks (724-776-8100) will not have this feature added. Internal campus calls dialing 8xxx will not be affected.
