Water Update

Cranberry Township announced a boil alert for Sherwood Oaks, Meeder, Laurelwood and some neighboring communities. Currently no end date noted on the website, but we anticipate 2-3 days. As a precaution, we advise independent living residents to boil water through Friday evening, September 8. A slide is running on Channels 950 & 951 as a reminder and will be updated as we receive additional information.

We activated our emergency water supply and dining services delivered a gallon of water yesterday to each independent living residence and to the health center units for drinking and brushing teeth.

Additional water will be delivered to IL residents today. Water jugs will be left outside your front door. Community Center water fountains have been taken out of service.
