We are receiving reports from residents about scam calls from Publisher's Clearing House. A male caller states that you have won \$2 million, along with a Chevy truck. All you must do is send \$2,500 to the IRS in advance. This is a scam! Do not give out any information and hang up.

The robo calling feature that was recently installed on the campus phones does block robo calls and automated calls from being connected to you. Unfortunately, this type of scam involves an individual caller who can press #8 to be connected to you. Please use caution when answering phone calls.

## **Emergency Heat**

A reminder for emergency heat as we move into the Fall season:

- ✓ Turn on "Emergency Heat/Auxiliary Heat" when the outside temperature is expected to be below 35 degrees.
- ✓ Turn back to "<u>Heat</u>" when the outside temperature rises above 35 degrees.
