#### <u> Updated Masking Recommendations at Sherwood Oaks – Mark Bondi</u>

Due to an increase in RSV, COVID-19, and flu cases in the area, we are encouraging but not requiring masking in all areas of the Sherwood Oaks campus. At this time, there are no reported cases of these infections at Sherwood Oaks. As we have done in the past, if case numbers increase, we will require masking in specific areas as needed.

Additional Important Information:

- High Vaccination Rates: Both staff and residents at Sherwood Oaks have high vaccination rates.
- Visitation Policies Remain Unchanged: Even during periods of high infection rates, we will not deny access to individuals who choose not to follow masking recommendations.
